The received assessments of the intelligence information sent to the USSR are as follows:

Extremely valuable – 17 pieces of information  
Valuable - 24 pieces of information  
Information interest - 1 piece of information

Evaluation of our materials we have not received so far.

Among the most valuable technological and constructive materials, which we received from the USSR in the first quarter of 1980 are for the matrix processor AP 3838 and for the bubble memory. That documentation is complete and gave opportunities for our experts to start practical development on the matter.
