RESOLUTION P-1257
BY THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS
25 July 1962

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid to the Laos people

TO
Ministry of health and social care
Ministry of foreign trade
Ministry of finances
State planning committee

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

To render free assistance to the Laos people in their national independence struggle, sending the Laos government medications, dressing materials, medical equipment and other medical materials at the amount of 120 000 leva, as specified in Appendices 1, 2 and 3, and two tons of lead for printing to the value of 1 300 leva.

The Minister of national health and social care shall purchase the medical items at wholesale prices and deliver them in suitable for transportation packing to the Ministry of foreign trade, to be sent to Laos.

The Chairman of the State planning commission shall provide two tons of lead for printing and deliver it in suitable for transportation packing to the Ministry of foreign trade, to be sent to Laos.

The Minister of foreign trade shall organize the transfer of medical items and lead to the Laos government, headed by Suvana Fuma.

Funds necessary to cover the cost of medical items, lead and packing, as well as transportation to Laos, shall be allocated by the Ministry of finance from the government reserve in the Republican budget for 1962.

The execution of this order is the responsibility of the Minister of national health and social care, the Chairman of the State planning commission, the Minister of foreign trade and the Minister of finance.
